

his appeal, made by the JJ Metta Memorial Foundation, Inc. is dedicated to raising funds for the Sphoorti Children's Home—a unique, comprehensive program serving orphaned, disadvantaged, and neglected children in Hyderabad, one of India's largest cities. Currently, the Home serves 135 children, ages 7 to 17.

The JJ Metta Memorial Foundation, dedicates its time and resources to raising funds to help underprivileged children. Fund raising appeals by the Foundation are a primary source of funding.

## **The Population Served**

Most children in the Sphoorti Children's Home were living on the streets, begging for food and struggling to survive. Many were orphaned or separated from their families and some were forced into the sex trade.

There were no alternatives for these children. In 2009, it was estimated that 1.2 million Indian children worked in brothels (CNN, May 11, 2009).

## The Children's LIFE Program

The Home's LIFE program—Loving, Inspiring, Fulfilling and Enlightening—offers a variety of services, including:

- Diagnosis and intake assessment
- Shelter in a warm, culturally relevant, and healthy environment
- Medical\* and nutritional care
- Basic education (teachers\*)
- Ongoing counseling and support, including music and art therapy
- Skill building for future employability
- Follow-up after placement in the community
- \*The program relies on volunteers to provide some technical services.

## **Support/Donations Sought**

Our primary goals in seeking donations include:

- Continuing support for the Home's LIFE program
- Increasing the number of children served
- Obtaining or building a separate facility for Project Girl Child to better serve girls rescued from the streets and sex trade
- Communicating what is learned to agencies and organizations throughout the world that may wish to replicate this model

No donations are too small—a little can go a long way. All levels of donation are appreciated:

- \$1 a month feeds a child for two days (food is supplemented from other sources)
- \$16 a month provides training and therapeutic services for one month per child
- \$35 a month provides education, including tuition, uniforms, supplies, books, and transportation per child

Administrative costs are kept at a minimum because volunteers and donated time are used to operate the JJ Metta Memorial Foundation.

You may adopt\* an incoming child for one year for \$100. In so doing, you will receive the child's picture and related information, and periodic progress reports.
